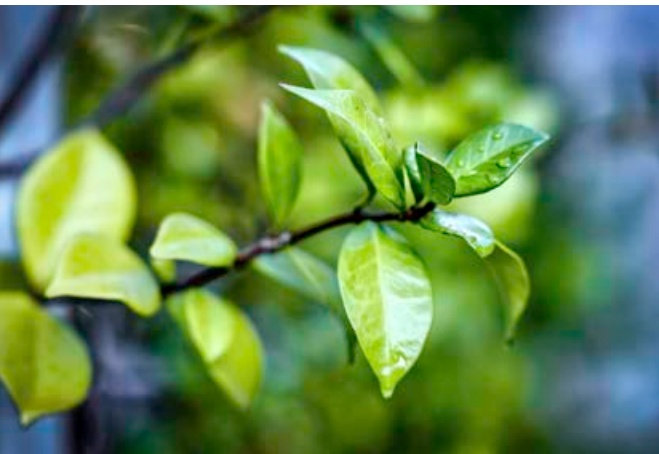

Blending classic safari style with refined elegance, twelve private suites create a sense of effortless sophistication and timeless comfort in perfect harmony with the landscape.

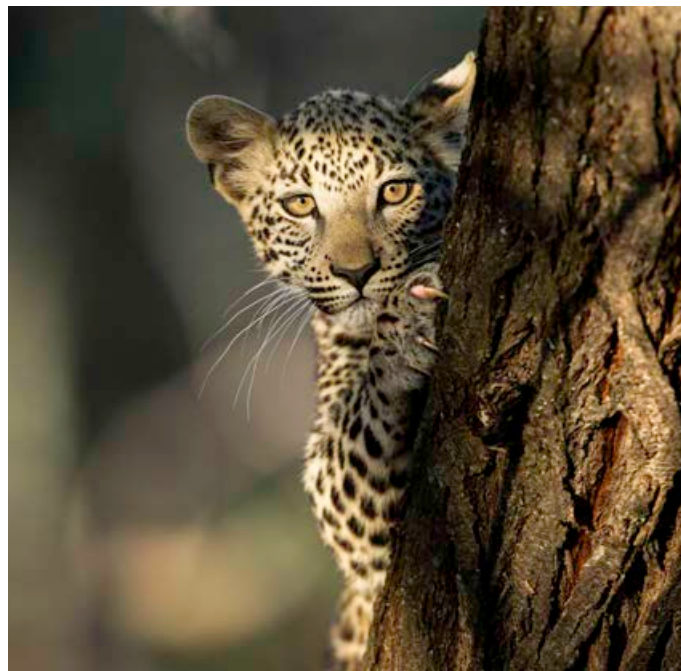

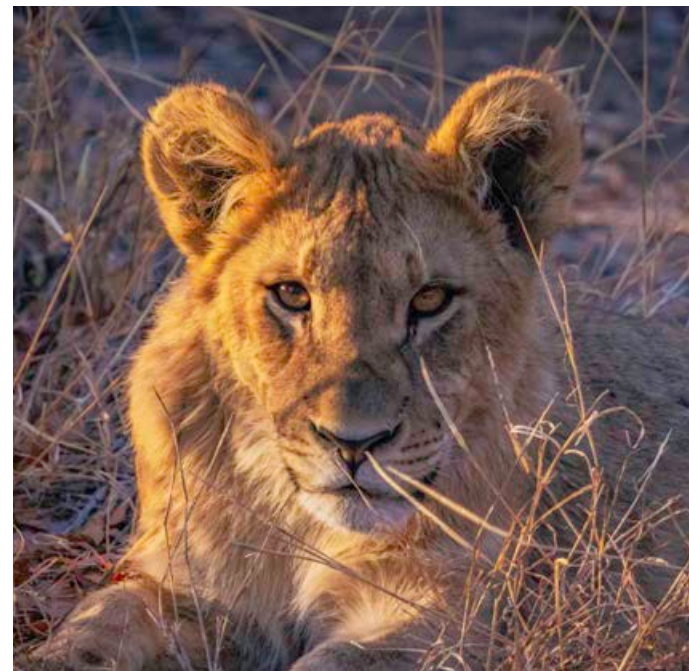


The Mushara Collection is an oasis of hospitality and bespoke service, where the staff are the Spirit behind the brand.

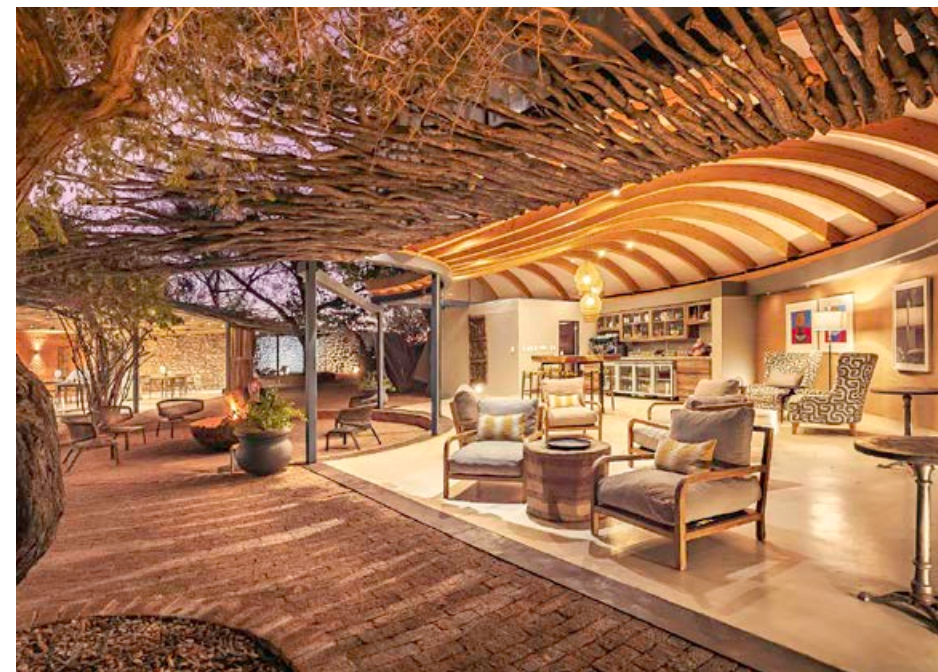

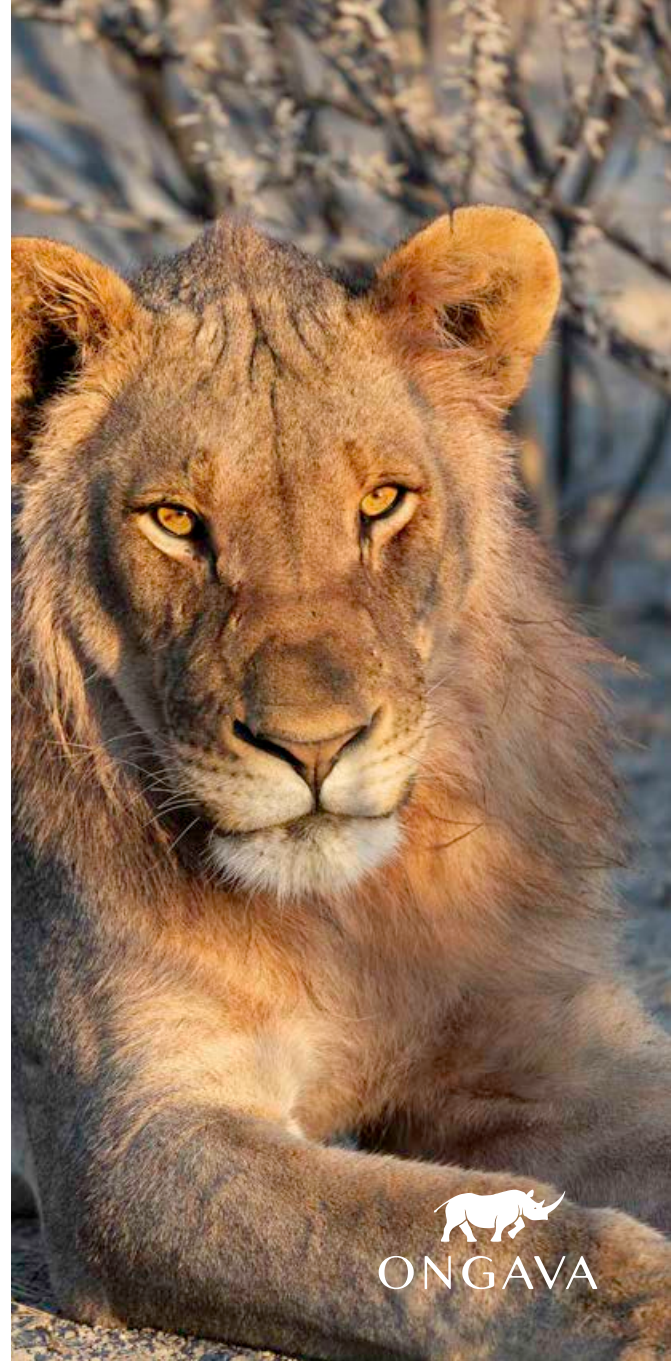
Their experienced and enthusiastic guides will embellish you with their intricate knowledge of the Etosha pan, the flora and fauna and the diverse animal species you will encounter.

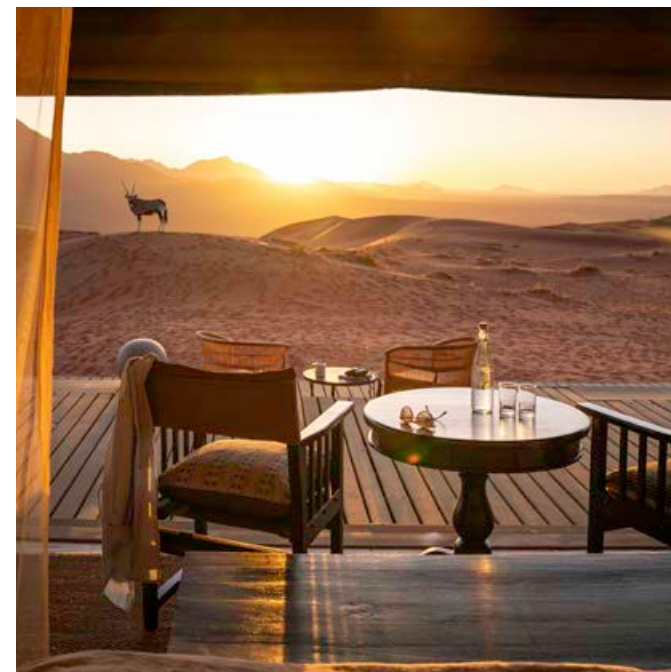
Your journey of a lifetime will also help the Namib Sky Community School programme, which enables local kids to reach new heights themselves.

Set within the 25,000-hectare Sinclair Nature Reserve, Nooishof is all about wide open spaces, beautiful scenery and magical colours.

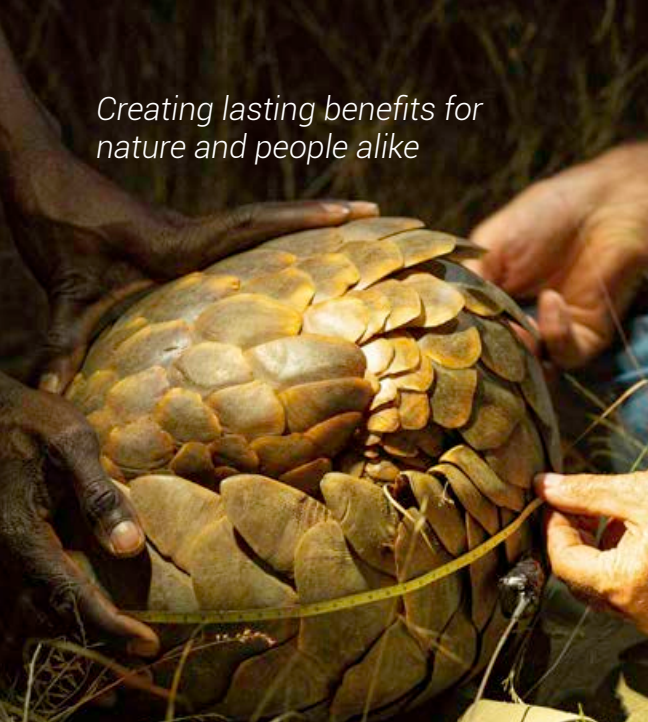

Through these combined efforts, we're ensuring that the natural wonders of Namibia—from its ancient deserts to its diverse wildlife—will continue to thrive for generations to come.





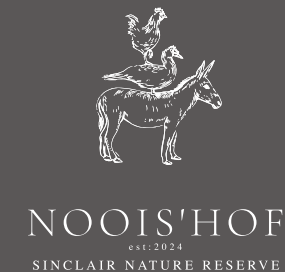
